August 7, 2023	Kick-off program of the 2023 Badang Brigada project at Tiposu Elementary School, Tiposu, Urdaneta City. Participated by the parents, barangay council, and the UCU family headed by Dr. Josephine S. Lambinico, VP for Academic Affairs, Dr. Raquel D. Pascua, VP for Administrative Affairs, Dr. Princess Sarah M. Quintana, Dean College of Arts and Sciences, Extension Coordinators from various colleges and departments, Dr. Jerry Dichoso, Director of Center for Community Development and Extension Services. The Badang Brigada Eskwela Project is composed of School Donation Drive whereby pupils belonging to low-income families are given school supplies (10 pupils per grade level or 60 pupils per school), Badang Pagbasa, children are given the opportunity to read and storytelling, and Badang Clean-up drive, assisting the schools to welcome the learners with clean and child-friendly school facilities. A simultaneous Badang project is also conducted at Bactad Community School with the College of Teacher Education with the assistance of EMAS, SMO, and the GSO department. Distribution of school supplies was made to 60 learners and a clean-up drive and inspection of electrical facilities.
