In pursuit of our commitment to gender equality and inclusive education, Urdaneta City University is pleased to announce a set of access schemes aimed at supporting women in their academic and professional journeys. Through these initiatives, we aim to create an environment where women have equal opportunities to excel, particularly in fields where they have historically been underrepresented.

1. Mentorship Programs for Women

UCU will be launching a mentorship initiative, connecting women students with experienced faculty, alumni, and professionals.
