

#### PROJECT PROPOSAL

- I. Title: LEADERSHIP CAPABILITY TRAINING Year I

  Theme: Panangtarabay Kadagiti Agtutubo; para iti Napintas nga Panangidaulo
- II. Project Beneficiaries: Student leaders from grades 7 to 12 high school students of:
  - a) Cabaruan National High School, Cabaruan, Urdaneta City
  - b) Labit National High School, Labit East, Urdaneta City
  - c) Palina East National High School, Palina East, Urdaneta City
- III. **Project Implementer**: UCU-Center for Community Development and Extension Services (CCDES) and UCU Student Council
- IV. Project Proponent: Center for Community Development and Extension Services and UCU Student Council
- V. Time Frame: October 5, 2023 to January 2024
- VI. VENUE: a) Cabaruan National High School, Cabaruan, Urdaneta City
  - b) Labit National High School, Labit East, Urdaneta City
  - c) Palina East National High School, Palina East, Urdaneta City
- VII. PROJECT COST: Php 1,000.00, and self-help from adopted schools
- VIII. RATIONALE:

The Leadership Capability Training with the "Theme: Panangtarabay Kadagiti Agtutubo; Para iti Napintas nga Panangidaulo" was conceptualized to support and guide the student leaders in the secondary schools respectively the Cabaruan National High School, Labit National High School, and Palina East National High School in strengthening their moral values and character building to become more effective young leaders in their school. They are the standards that help the students choose between right and wrong and discern between good and bad. One of the goals of the Department of Education is to provide and promote values education at all levels of the education system. Article XIV Section 1 "The state shall protect and promote the right of all citizens to quality education at all level, and shall take appropriate steps to make such education accessible to all" and Section 8 of the Philippine Constitution, asserts the first official state policy on values education and provides that all educational institutions shall aim to develop moral character, personal discipline, civic conscience, and vocational efficiency, and teach the duties of citizenship. Our university, being an educational institution and partner of the community in establishing and strengthening the youths on their moral values and character, has the responsibility to support them by conducting leadership capability pieces of training of the students in our adopted schools.
