

From February 8 to 10, 2023, Urdaneta City University’s Center of Training and Professional Development held the second phase of its Professional Regulation Commission (PRC) accredited CPD program on advanced research writing. The three-day onsite workshop, “Research Writing: Statistical Data Analysis, Results and Discussion, Conclusion, and Recommendation,” provided teachers with an opportunity to earn eight Continuing Professional Development (CPD) units while enhancing their research skills. Held at the University Cafeteria, the event attracted numerous educators eager to deepen their understanding of data analysis and refine their research presentation techniques.

The program featured a carefully curated lineup of topics, beginning with statistical data analysis and moving through the critical stages of results and discussion, concluding with sections on crafting effective conclusions and recommendations. Participants were also introduced to essential guidelines for paper presentation and publication, equipping them with skills for broader academic dissemination of their work. Each session was led by research experts, allowing attendees to gain valuable insights and ask questions to deepen their practical knowledge.

Teachers registered by scanning a QR code or using an online link, reflecting the university’s seamless approach to participant engagement. UCU’s Center of Training and Professional Development expressed its gratitude for the high level of participation, noting that the onsite format allowed for dynamic, face-to-face interactions that fostered a richer learning experience.





By the end of the program, participants left not only with CPD units but also with renewed confidence in their ability to conduct thorough, publishable research. The event demonstrated UCU's commitment to empowering educators in their professional growth and supporting their contributions to academic research in the Philippines.
